Welcome to Mana Island

Please advise island staff upon your arrival. If staff cannot be found, please sign the visitors' book in the boat shed.

The woolshed houses displays about the history and conservation of Mana Island.

The Tirohanga Track takes 1.5 hours to walk at a leisurely pace. The remains of the old lighthouse can be seen near the summit of Mana above the northern cliffs. The southern track adds about half an hour to the walk.

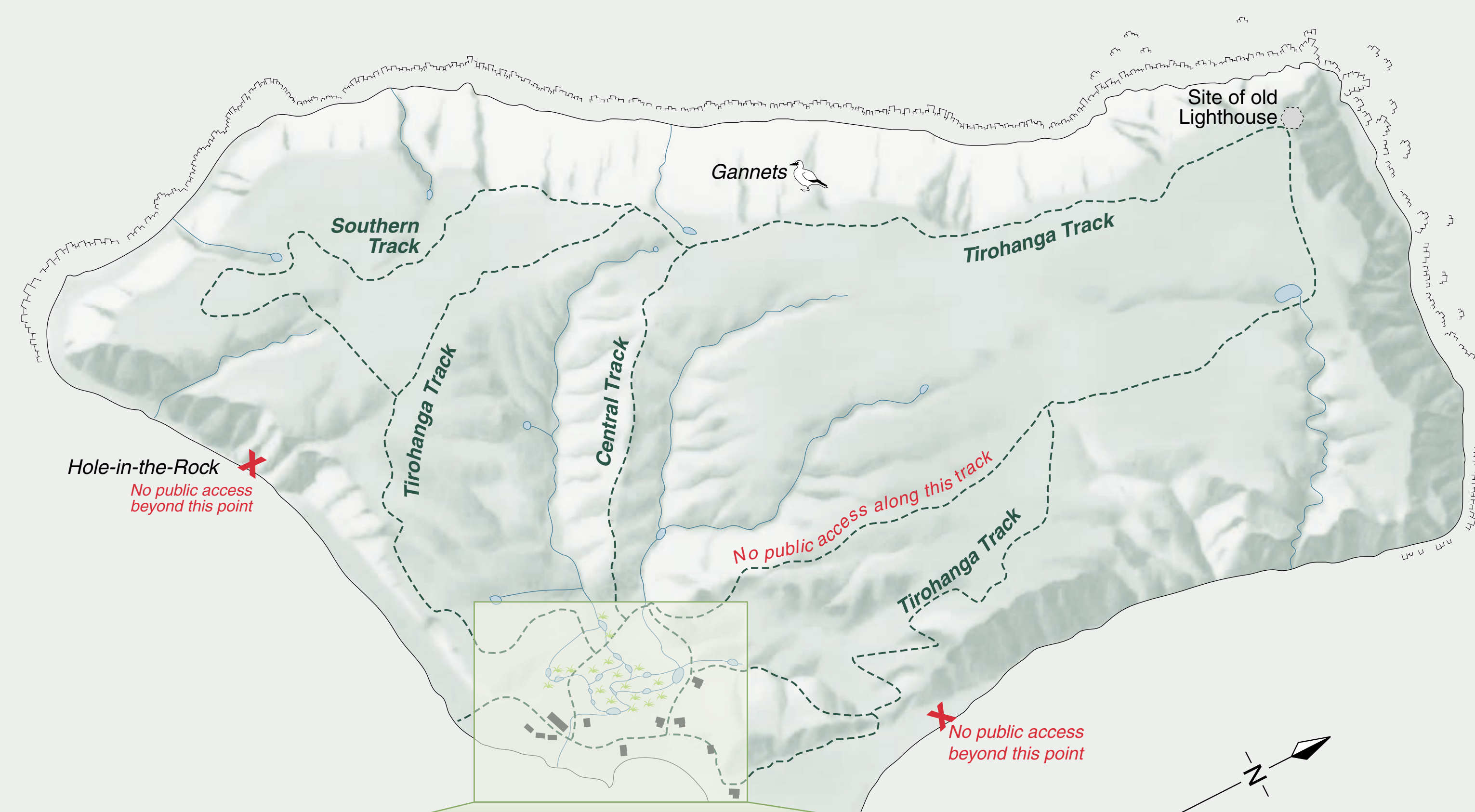
An artificial gannet colony has been installed overlooking the western cliffs. This is an attempt to attract wild gannets to adopt Mana Island as a new breeding site.

The Waikoko wetland, on the flat beyond the houses and nursery, has been restored to provide habitat for wetland wildlife. Interpretation panels and observation hide are located at the lookout on the western side of the wetland, accessed off the wetland loop track.



Public access is restricted to the formed tracks and the beach areas adjacent to this bay. Please do not walk along the coast beyond Shingle Spit to the north or the 'Hole-in-the-Rock' to the south, as shown on the map.

Please remember that all plants, wildlife, natural features and historic features are protected, and nothing may be removed.
